Fin2Fit Teacher Code of Conduct

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Code of Conduct for Instructors & Volunteers

Fin2Fit Teachers and volunteers have a great opportunity to be a positive role model and help build an individual's confidence.

Teachers and volunteers are expected to:

- 1. Adhere to all Triton Training and Fin2Fit policies and procedures relevant to the teacher role.
- 2. Ensure the safety of all swimmers by providing safe supervision, developmental planning and safe methods of organisation.
- 3. Ensure the wellbeing and safety of swimmers before the development of performance.
- 4. Be positive, approachable and offer praise to promote the ethos of the Fin2Fit at all times.
- 5. Appreciate the efforts of all swimmers and not over-train.
- 6. Respect and listen to the opinions of all swimmers.
- 7. Take time to explain teaching techniques to ensure they are clearly understood.
- 8. Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants, based on mutual trust and respect.
- 9. Display consistently high standards of professional conduct and appearance.
- 10. Treat all young people fairly and ensure they feel valued.
- 11. Demonstrate equality and diversity in all activity, encouraging all swimmers to be welcoming and inclusive.
- 12. Manage behaviour within sessions and prohibit any dangerous play, bullying, the use of bad language or inappropriate behaviour.
- 13. Establish and plan for adaptations to meet the additional needs of disabled participants or other vulnerable groups.
- 14. Not abuse members physically, emotionally or sexually.
- 15. Encourage and guide swimmers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- 16. Ensure the rights and responsibilities of youth members are enforced.
- 17. Never exert undue influence over swimmers to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- 18. Challenge any concerns or allegations of abuse of any kind including poor practice.
- 19.Record incidents and accidents in the line with Fin2Fit policies and procedures as well as specific site procedures.
- 20. Never use sanctions that humiliate or harm swimmers.
- 21. When qualified administer first aid or refer to the site specific first aider.
- 22. Have access to telephone for immediate contact to emergency services if required.
- 23. Not engage in a sexual relationship with a young person for whom they are responsible.
- 24. Maintain confidentiality about sensitive information.

Teachers and volunteers have the right to:

- 1. Support for future development.
- 2. Support in the reporting suspected abuse or poor practice.
- 3. Access to all Triton Training & Fin2Fit template documentation, policies and procedures.
- 4. Fair and equitable treatment by the governing body Triton Training and Fin2Fit.
- 5. Be protected from abuse by children/youths, other adult members and parents.
- 6. Not to be left vulnerable when working with children.
- 7. Any misdemeanour's will be dealt with immediately and reported verbally to Triton Training & Fin2Fit as well as the site specific designated person.
- 8. Serious or persistent breach of the code will result in disciplinary action and could lead to the withdrawal from Fin2Fit sessions.
- 9. Withdrawals can be appealed by the teacher/volunteer with final decisions referred to Triton Training and Fin2Fit, potentially the governing body.

All Teachers and volunteers should be prepared. This Will Include:

- 1. A current site specific emergency action plan and access to First Aid equipment.
- 2. Reception / Management / First Aid support.
- 3. Telephone contact to the Emergency Services.
