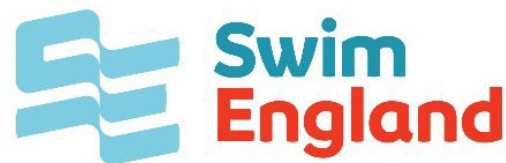


Course Overview



Swim England L2 Teaching Swimming

This course is the second step on your pathway to becoming a fully qualified Level 2 Swimming Teacher. The course develops your knowledge, skills and abilities as a swimming teacher. It builds on the SEQ Level 1 Swimming Assistant (Teaching) qualification and gives you the skills to independently plan and deliver swimming lessons.

Candidates must meet the following criteria as prerequisites:

- Be 16 years+ at the point of Enrolment.
- Hold the SEQ Level 1 Swimming Assistant (Teaching) qualification or equivalent Swim England/ASA qualification certificated after 1994.
- Learners must have all pre-requisites in place before the start of the course. Qualification certificates cannot be issued if all pre-requisites are not met before the start of the course, post course submissions will not be accepted.

On the Swim England Level 2 course you will cover the following subjects:

- The role and responsibilities of a swimming teacher
- How the scientific principles of swimming impact on learners development
- How to develop core aquatic skills and the four strokes
- How to identify and correct common swimming faults
- How to assess ability and use a variety of teaching techniques and equipment to suit different needs
- How to plan and deliver inclusive lessons for different levels of ability. Includes adaptations for learners with special educational needs and disabilities.
- Key teaching and management skills including class management and assessment, safety and safeguarding, time management and organisational skills, behaviour management, communication skills, teaching methods and motivational techniques
- National curriculum swimming lessons and how they differ from learn to swim lessons
- How to plan for your professional development
- Personal Evaluation
- Action Planning

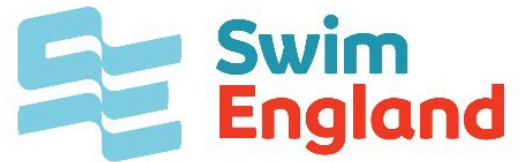
During the course you will cover peer teaching for strokes and skills. Teaching and practical demonstrations within lessons. You will need to deliver a total of six lessons each 30minutes in duration demonstrating supervision and direction within the lessons to the below stages of the Swim England Learn to Swim Programme:

- Stage 1 or 2 (water confidence)
- Stage 3 (Body Position)
- Stage 4 or 5 (Leg Kick or Arm Pull focus)
- Stage 6 or 7 (Timing and Breathing Focus)
- All four strokes must be covered within the lessons.

All of the lessons delivered will be planned during Theory sessions.

Course Delivery Sessions

You must attend 100% of classroom, online classroom sessions and practical pool sessions as well as submit all homework and coursework on time for marking to complete the course successfully.

Assessment:

On day one of your course you will be supplied with an official SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming Theory workbook which you will complete during your course and will be reviewed throughout by your tutor. The Theory workbook will form the first part of your assessment and must be complete and competent by the final day of your course. You will also be asked to produce 6 lesson plans, 2 long-term overviews, 6 evaluations and a professional Action plan to complete your theory work.

Throughout the course you will have a number of practical observations within the lessons you teach where your tutor will observe your interactions within the lessons and where you will demonstrate your new skills gained on the course. At this point the tutor will complete your Observation Record which forms the second part of your Assessment. Your tutor will also be able to provide you with feedback for your development.

Following each of your practical lessons you will complete an evaluation of how you feel you performed and where you can make improvements for your own development and action plan for the future. This will form the final part of your assessment and once completed will complete your course.
