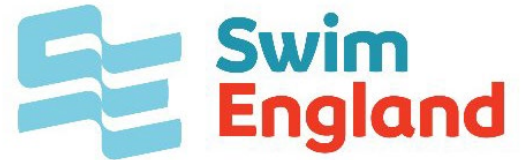

Swim England

Level 2 Teaching Swimming to Babies and Toddlers

This course develops your knowledge, skills and abilities as a swimming teacher for babies and toddlers/pre-school children. It builds on the SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming qualification and gives you the skills to independently plan and deliver a series of baby and toddler swimming lessons.

Candidates must meet the following criteria as prerequisites:

- Be 16 years+ at the point of Enrolment.
- Hold the SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming qualification or equivalent Swim England/ASA qualification certificated after 1994.
- Learners must have all pre-requisites in place before the start of the course. Qualification certificates cannot be issued if all pre-requisites are not met before the start of the course, post course submissions will not be accepted.

On the Swim England Level 2 Teaching swimming to babies and toddlers course you will cover the following subjects:

SEQ Level 2 Theory

- How early years development, stages of play and reflexes impact on swimming ability
- Special Educational Needs and Disabilities, health-related conditions and how to respond and adapt to them
- How to introduce and teach the core aquatic skills in a fun way
- The different supports and holds to use in lessons
- The advantages and disadvantages of different types of equipment
- How to plan, adapt and teach lessons which cater for groups with different levels of ability
- Key teaching and lesson management skills

SEQ Level 2 Practical

- The type of assistance you can provide
- Practical teaching methods
- Poolside and in-water teaching
- Demonstrations
- Communication Methods

During the course you will cover peer teaching for strokes and skills. Teaching and practical demonstrations within lessons. You will need to deliver a total of six lessons each 30minutes in duration demonstrating supervision and direction within the lessons to the below stages of the Swim England Learn to Swim Programme:

- 0-18 months
- 18 months - 3 years old
- 3-5 years old

All of the lessons delivered will be planned during Theory sessions.

Course Delivery Sessions

You must attend 100% of classroom, online classroom sessions and practical pool sessions as well as submit all homework and coursework on time for marking to complete the course successfully.

Assessment:

On day one of your course you will be supplied with an official SEQ Level 2 Teaching swimming to babies and toddlers Theory workbook which you will complete during your course and will be reviewed throughout by your tutor. The Theory workbook will form the first part of your assessment and must be complete and competent by the final day of your course. You will also be asked to produce 6 lesson plans, 2 long-term overviews, 6 evaluations and a professional Action plan to complete your theory work.

Throughout the course you will have a number of practical observations within the lessons you teach where your tutor will observe your interactions within the lessons and where you will demonstrate your new skills gained on the course. At this point the tutor will complete your Observation Record which forms the second part of your Assessment. Your tutor will also be able to provide you with feedback for your development.

Following each of your practical lessons you will complete an evaluation of how you feel you performed and where you can make improvements for your own development and action plan for the future. This will form the final part of your assessment and once completed will complete your course.
