The Level 2 STA Award in Teaching Swimming is the perfect step to begin your exciting career as a swimming teacher and with no previous experience required, you can get started right away.

The course develops the your vocational skills and technical knowledge to qualify as a qualified swimming teacher, allowing you to independently teach your very own class of 12 participants from non-swimmers up to improvers (children and adults). This qualification is recognised internationally, allowing you to take your swimming teaching career around the world.

Candidates must meet the following criteria as prerequisites:

- Be 16 years+ at the point of assessment
- Hold current membership of STA.
- Learners must have all pre-requisites in place before the start of the course.
 Qualification certificates cannot be issued if all pre-requisites are not met before the start of the course, post course submissions will not be accepted.

Course Delivery Sessions

You must attend 100% of classroom, online classroom sessions and practical pool sessions as well as submit all homework and coursework on time for marking to complete the course successfully.

You will also have observations within the lessons you teach where your tutor will observe your interactions within the lessons and where you will demonstrate your new skills gained on the course. At this point the tutor will complete your Observation Record which forms the second part of your Assessment. Your tutor will also be able to provide you with feedback for your development.



Assessment

On the final day of this course you will also sit a multiple choice examination (30 questions) and be externally assessed by an independent assessor who will verify that your qualification will be awarded.
