Assessment:

This is a tutor-assessed course, with both theory and practical elements. All assessment criteria must be met for a learner to pass. Assessments include:

- Three detailed lesson plans (minimum 45 minutes each)
- One facilitated session with real or peer participants
- Practical evaluation of delivery
- Completed worksheets



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• Plan for professional development

Assessment must be completed within a 28-day window starting from the first day of assessment. Reassessment is required if any part is failed.

Renewal:

The AAA qualification must be renewed every 2 years. To renew, learners must:

- Present a valid certificate
- Provide ID
- · Complete an online CPD renewal training
